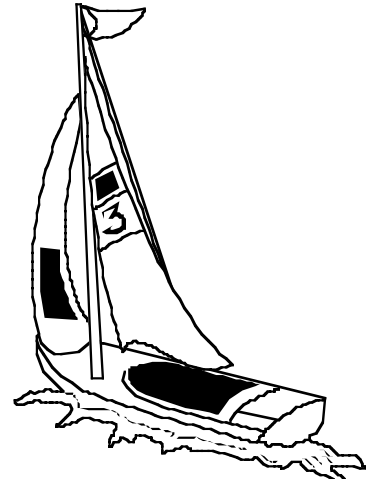

BOAT DISPOSAL

Take three easy steps to properly dispose of privately owned boats such as small pleasure craft.

- 1. Deliver your boat to the Regional Landfill**
Boat must be no larger than 8 x 21 feet and made of fiberglass or wood only. It must be delivered in or by a privately owned, non-commercial automobile, station wagon, passenger van, mini-van or unmodified, low-side pickup truck.

If delivered utilizing a trailer, the trailer should be a conventional boat trailer or else no larger than a pickup truck bed.

- 2. Present Proof of Residency**
Car decal sticker or other identification must show that you are a resident of SPSA's service area (Chesapeake, Franklin, Isle of Wight, Norfolk, Portsmouth, Southampton, Suffolk and Virginia Beach).

- 3. Off-load Your Boat**
Landfill personnel will direct you to the appropriate location to unload your boat.

It's that easy to properly dispose of your boat!

*This is a free service from the Southeastern Public Service Authority available **only** to residents of SPSA's service area .*

USER INFORMATION

- Boats must be free of gasoline or other petroleum products. Use SPSA's free, residential used oil recycling program for proper disposal of used motor oil and the free Household Hazardous Waste Collection program to properly dispose of gasoline and other fuels.
- Motors, anchors and rigging must be removed prior to delivery to the landfill.
- Boats which have been dismantled also are acceptable, although limitations may apply. Call (757) 539-9373 for information.
